Oslofjord Convention Center offers everything in one location, with social meeting spaces both indoors and outdoors. Traveling to Oslofjord

The Oslofjord Convention Center is situated in Vestfold, a coastal region with excellent transport connections. The venue is easily accessible by car, plane, or train. Sandefjord Airport Torp is just 15 minutes away, whilst Oslo Airport Gardermoen is a 90-minute drive from the location. This makes it convenient to reach from destinations throughout Norway and internationally. The center's staff are available to assist with travel planning and can provide guidance on the various transport options to ensure smooth arrivals and departures for all attendees.

By Plane

Sandefjord Airport Torp

Oslofjord is only a 15-minute drive from Sandefjord Airport Torp, which has direct domestic and international flights, including to and from Bergen, Copenhagen and Amsterdam.

Oslo Airport Gardermoen

Oslo Airport Gardermoen is Norway's main airport with direct routes to destinations across Europe. Only a 90-minute drive to Oslofjord.

By Car

More than 1.500 parking spaces

Take the exit from the E18 to Stokke via the RV 303 and follow the signs towards Oslofjord Convention Center. Our parking facilities can accommodate more than 1.500 cars and most of the parking spaces are underground, which enables you to walk indoors all the way from the Arena to Oslofjord Hotel and the hotel buildings.

Electric cars:

85 pcs. charging points (up to 7.4kW) in the parking basement between Oslofjord Hotel and Oslofjord Arena. 25 pcs. charging points (up to 22kW) in parking basement level U1 under Oslofjord Arena. All chargers have a Type 2 connector.



Parking system and rates:

Oslofjord has introduced Autopay as a parking system. This system registers entry and exit automatically using cameras.

Rates: NOK 15kr/h and 220kr/day



By Train

VY (formerly NSB)

The nearest train station is Stokke, which is a 10-minute drive from Oslofjord. There are more than 20 daily departures from Oslo to Stokke and direct train connections from both Sandefjord Airport Torp and Oslo Airport Gardermoen.

Packages & Accommodation

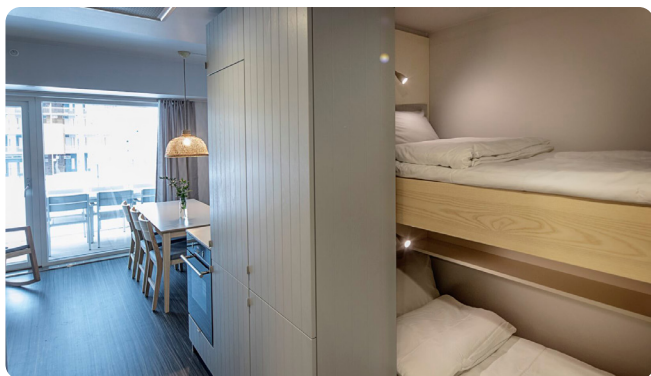
Hotel apartments, competition packages and ERSO fees.



At Oslofjord we reserved comfortable apartments. Each is fully equipped with a bathroom (including a washing machine), a bedroom with two beds, two bunk beds in a separate room, and a living area featuring a sofa and dining table. The kitchenette comes with a water kettle and coffee machine, and all units include a private balcony or veranda. Towels and bed linen are provided for all guests.

The organisation planned 4-bed apartments close to the competition area and has to be booked directly through the Oslofjord Convention Center website.



Price

The daily rate of 1,600 NOK per person includes full board accommodation with three meals throughout the day. Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served in the Oasis restaurant at the Convention Center South.

The apartments can be booked at this rate from 9th August until 17th August (note that this includes the night from the 17th to the 18th as well).

Please note:

The accommodation is also available for supporters and parents to book. However, if bookings exceed the number of available apartment beds, priority will be given to competition participants.

Competition packages

All active participants – including athletes, coaches, judges, officials, and medical personnel – require a competition package to access the competition venues. Without the appropriate accreditation, entry to the competition areas will not be permitted. Please note that these packages are exclusively for active participants and are not available for supporters.

Choosing the right package

Packages should match your event presence. Athletes must purchase the package corresponding to their registration. For example, if you compete in any EC event, you need an EC package regardless of whether you advance to the finals. Upgrades to packages with additional days are possible, but downgrades are not permitted. This means an EC participant can upgrade to a FULL package but cannot downgrade to a JEC package.

What is included

Each competition package includes:

- access to the competition areas for the specified dates,
- entry to the spectator seating areas for the days covered by your package without requiring separate day tickets,
- attendance at the opening ceremony and closing party,
- and a welcome package with an event t-shirt.

ERSO fees

All athletes, coaches, officials and medical personal must register through ERSO to access competition and warm-up floor. The registration fee is 35,- € per person.

Athletes must also pay a competition fee for each event entered:

- EOT events: 7,50 € per athlete/per event
- EC/JEC/DDC events: 10,00 € per athlete/per event

Registration as an athlete, coach, etc. is only available to those who have booked accommodation through the Oslofjord Convention Center.

Registration details

Deadlines, cancellation policy, and payment details

We want to make the registration process as straightforward as possible for everyone. In this chapter you will find important information about registration deadlines, where to register, our cancellation policy, and payment details.

Where to register

Registration deadline

There are two deadlines in place: the pre-registration and the final registration deadlines.

Pre-registration (estimation)	March 31 st
Final registration (locking entries)	June 6 th

Cancellation policy:

We understand that plans may change. For this event the following dates and policies applies:

Before June 6th	100% refund
June 6th - 20th	50% refund
June 21th - July 11th	25% refund
After July 11th	No refund

Changes after final registration

Please note that changes made after the final registration deadline will incur an administration fee of €10 per request. This applies to modifications such as athlete or coach additions, event changes, and music updates. Changes necessitated by exceptional circumstances will be evaluated individually.



Payment process

All invoices will be issued directly to the NGBs based on the information provided in either the pre-registration form or the IJRU registration system. The details registered in the system are considered final and will form the basis of your invoice.

Each invoice will include complete payment details and the final payment deadline (30 days after sending the invoice). Payment must be made from the NGB's registered bank account in a single transaction. We cannot accept payments from individual participants or multiple partial payments. Please ensure that your NGB settles the invoice by the specified deadline, as late payment may jeopardise participation.

Spectator information

About tickets and supporting

Tickets and spectating

Spectator tickets will be available for anyone wishing to watch the championships. If you hold a competition package, entrance to the spectator areas for the days covered by your package is already included, so no additional tickets are required. Ticket prices and purchasing information are yet to be confirmed. NGBs will receive updates regarding ticket sales, and all information will also be published on our website and social media channels when available.

Staying as a Supporter

Supporters who wish to stay on-site at the Oslofjord Convention Center can book accommodation directly through the venue. The accommodation includes full board with breakfast, lunch, and dinner provided. Supporters will need to purchase spectator tickets separately to watch the competitions. Accommodation bookings are made directly with Oslofjord Convention Center, though some NGBs may arrange bookings on behalf of their supporters.
